## Success Tips #27

### What a Talent Agent Wants

1. Actors who are acting for money. Agents earn 10% of what the actor makes. If you don't earn anything, neither do they.
2. Actors who are getting cast on their own. They have been in plays, students films, web ads, it really doesn't matter what the work is, as long as the actor has a history of getting cast.
3. Actors who work hard at getting good enough to compete for jobs - actors with the right attitude.
4. Actors who hustle.

### What a Talent Agent Doesn't Want

1. Actors who haven't made the commitment to act for money.
  2. Actors who haven't bothered to do much without anyone else's help.
  3. Actors who believe an agent can make it happen. Agents don't make actors, actors make agents.
  4. Actors who have an attitude because they don't understand point #3. They think the agent doesn't care about talent.
  5. Actors who think agents don't know what they are doing. (Maybe the agent knows what she's doing and the actor doesn't know what he's doing.)
- Now, these 'observable realities' can lead us to only one conclusion with regards to your "Getting an agent" problem. IT CAN BE DONE ... IF you are the type of actor they are looking for.
