Whether you are a rookie or have years of experience, the more you audition the more job opportunities you have waiting for you.

Therefore, keep a positive mental attitude. It will make you feel better in the short term and help you be more successful in the long term. Victory is not always to the swiftest but the one who keeps running. Even Mel Blanc pounded the pavement before Warner Bros. hired him to voice cartoons.
