Voices.com, the voice-over marketplace, is home to the largest community of voice actors online and facilitates industry events such as the Voicery Awards in addition to various resources including the Voice Over Experts podcast, the VOX Daily blog and the now infamous "Saturday Giveaway".

You can create a profile, upload samples of your voice, and even audition for jobs on a daily basis depending on the membership level you subscribe to. At Voices.com, we offer a basic membership called Guest (which has its limitations) and paid services called Preferred, Premium and Platinum.

Right now, we're in the middle of a complete site redesign, so I'm not going to talk too much about how to use the site, however, the community is a special aspect of our service that I can share with you.

You can subscribe to our blogs and podcasts for free and comment on articles that interest you. You can also submit story ideas and get some publicity by sharing your voice over news.
